MAY DAY 2024: LEGAL CONSULTATIONS AT THE COURTHOUSE

Announcing the Shiawassee County Bar Association's Law Day Free Legal Consultation Fair. This year's event will take place Wednesday, May 1, 2024, from 8-11:30am at the Shiawassee County Circuit Courthouse. Local attorneys will be providing free 15-minute legal consultations in honor of Law Day. The Bar Association wishes to thank the local attorneys who have repeatedly donated their time for this traditional event, to benefit the community. The consultations will be offered the morning of May 1st on the main (second) floor of the old Courthouse, 208 N. Shiawassee St., Corunna, MI. Consultations are offered on a first come, first serve basis.

In 1961, Congress issued a joint resolution designating May 1 as the official date for celebrating Law Day, which was subsequently codified (U.S. Code, Title 36, Section 113). Every president since then has issued a Law Day proclamation on May 1 to celebrate the nation's commitment to the rule of law.

INTRO TO SCOA SERVICES

This month's Feature: Home Delivered Meals

Home delivered meals help seniors remain in their own homes by delivering not only a meal but also a Safety



Check, Monday through Friday. Homebound seniors 60 years and older who are referred to the meal program are assessed by our Home delivered Meals Assessor, Jaden Horak, to determine if they qualify for the delivered meal.

Typically, seniors in this program are homebound with medical or physical issues that keep them from being able to cook and purchase groceries. Sometimes seniors anticipating surgery will receive meals at home during their recovery. Caregivers and families like the fact that someone goes to the seniors home 5 days per week as a safety check too. There is a protocol in place to make sure that emergency contacts are called if a client doesn't answer the door.

Meals are delivered from the Durand Senior Center and the Owosso Senior Center. Having empathetic and trustworthy drivers is essential to this meal program. All employees have background checks done annually.

SCOA has 8 meal delivery drivers who have delivered 91,406 meals throughout Shiawassee County for the 2022-2023 Grant Year. The average cost per meal is \$7.07, and a suggested donation of \$3 per meal helps offset those costs.
